

EASY MASON JAR LID WREATHS



Supplies:
Mason Jar Lid
Twine or Yarn
Accessories: Flowers, Bell, Acorn, Leaves, Ribbon, and Buttons.

Supplies needed:
Scissors

Strong Glue (Hot glue works best)

Step One:

Lay out all the supplies and plan out your holiday wreath.

Step Two:

Start wrapping your lid with twine, yarn, or tied ribbon.

Step Three:

You can add the ribbon or red ric rac

Step Four:

Add any accessories. Fun buttons, cheerful flowers, cute ribbon, and more.

Step Five:

Tie a little string for hanging.

SNOWMAN LIDS

Supplies:

Flat Tin Lid

Paint: White, Black, Orange

Pompoms, Yarn

Mod Podge Glue

Supplies Needed:

Scissors

Paint brush (Qtips or Cotton Balls work to)

Table cover to not get paint everywhere



Step One:

Paint the Flat Tin Lid white and let dry. May take up two hours. If needed, a second coat of paint could be added.

Step Two:

After it dries, use the black paint to add eyes and mouth. With the orange paint, you can draw a nose on your snowman.

Optional:

The glue in your kit is Mod Podge. You can put on a thin layer to seal the paint on the lid.

Step Three:

It is cold out, use the glue to add the yarn and pompoms to make earmuffs.
