

# DIY Jar Napkin Luminaries



## Supplies:

**Mason Jar   Mod Podge   Paint Brush   Napkins   Flameless Candle**

### Step One:

Wash and dry your jar.  
Then separate your napkins so they are a thin one layer.



### Step Two:

Apply a thin coat of Mod Podge to one side of your jar to start.



### Step Five:

Brush a nice coat of Mod Podge to your napkin, starting with the edges of the napkin giving a nice coat all over.  
Let dry for a couple hours.

### Step Six:

Repeat Steps to the other side of the jar. After a day, use the Flameless Candle. You can decorate the jar with ribbon and other accessories.

### Step Three:

Place the napkin onto the jar pressing gently from the center outward.

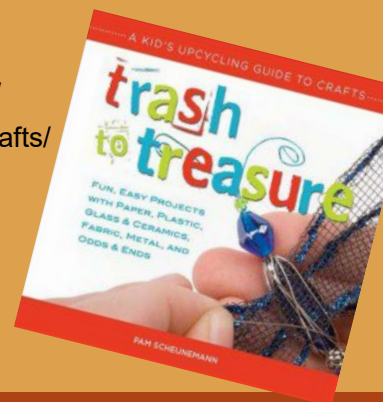


Tip: Don't be afraid to use a generous amount of glue but avoid dripping it.
