

Mason Jar Mod Podge Paint Brush Napkins Flameless Candle

Step One:

Wash and dry you jar. Then seperate your napkins so they are a thin one layer.

Step Two:

Apply a thin coat of Mod Podge to one side of your jar to start.



Step Three:

Place the napkin onto the jar pressing gently from the center outward.



Step Five:

Brush a nice coat of Mod Podge to your napkin, starting with the edges of the napkin giving a nice coat all over. Let dry for a couple hours.



Step Six:

Repeat Steps to the other side of the jar. After a day, use the Flameless Candle. You can decorate the jar with ribbon and other accessories.



Tip: Don't be afraid to use a generous amount of glue but avoid dripping it.


