- [What Kind of Clouds by Nadia Higgins, Sara Infante](#) Kids learn to watch the clouds to prepare for the day ahead. Catchy lyrics introduce the types of clouds and the weather they bring, while colorful illustrations support the concepts and make learning about science fun. This hardcover book comes with Cd and online music access.
- [My Head in the Clouds by Danielle Chaperon, Josée Bisailon](#) Travel the world with an intrepid explorer who's adventurous, brave and just a little bit forgetful. She searches for ancient loot but loses her swimsuit! Goes to beautiful places and misplaces three suitcases! From Canada to Nepal to Egypt and beyond, our narrator circles the globe while abandoning her possessions. She even loses her mother, briefly, in the desert.

In this endearing picture book, a rainy-day cityscape comes to life in vibrant, cut-paper-style artwork.
