Art Exploration Activity: Shapes Collage

Supplies

- Glue stick
- Sheet of cardstock
- A bag filled with tissue paper squares, triangles, and other shapes

Directions

- 1. Apply glue to the different shapes you would like to use. Press them onto your paper to create your collage, in any order you like!
- 2. Art activities are a great way to build your child's vocabulary. You can use words like lighter/darker, bigger/smaller, thinner/thicker to compare materials.

Here are some questions you can ask your child as you're working on your artwork:

- What colors do you see?
- What shapes do you see?
- What color do you like best?
- How does the tissue paper feel?
- What sound does the tissue paper make when you crinkle it?
- How are the tissue paper and regular paper different? How are they the same?
