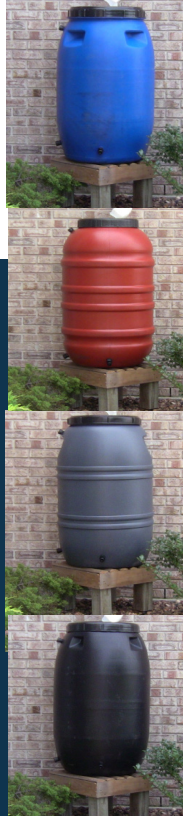
**A rain barrel promotes conservation
