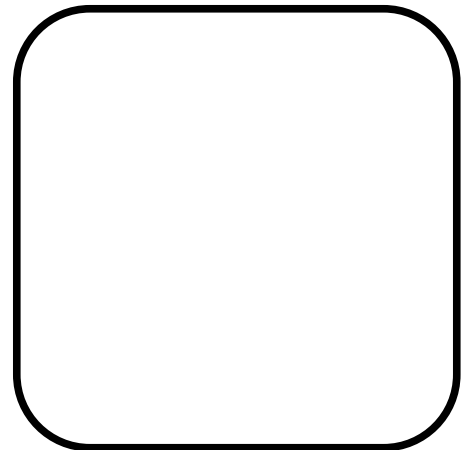
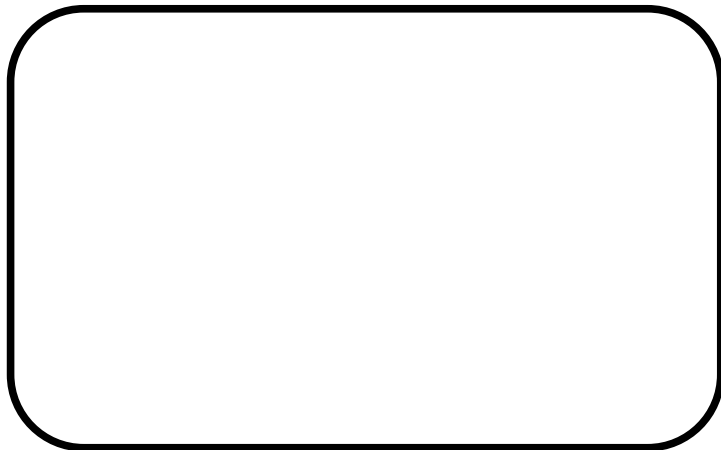
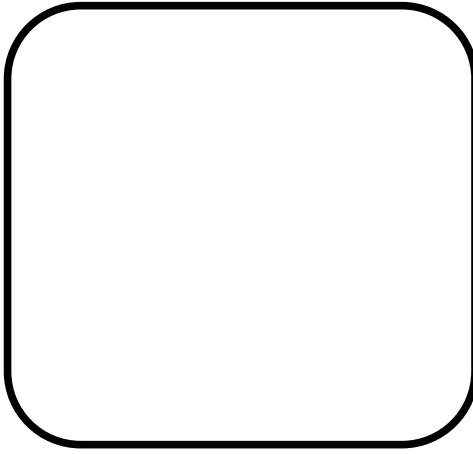














# Dr. Slime's Downtown Defeat

# Princess Power and the Bridge Calamity

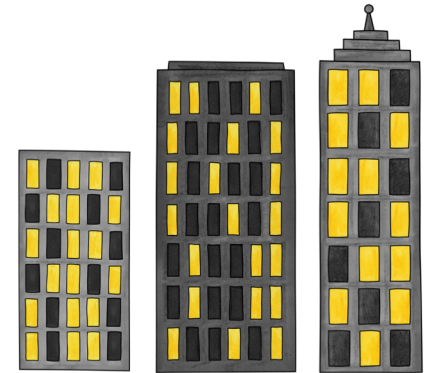
