Take-Home Kit: Art Exploration

Activity Instructions

Kit Contents:

- watercolor paper
- pipette for water
- bleeding tissue paper squares
- crayons

Instructions:

1. make marks on paper with crayon
2. use pipette to drop water on paper and move water around with fingers
3. place bleeding tissue paper squares all over the wet paper
4. remove tissue paper squares after the color has bled onto the paper or when dry
5. tissue paper squares can be reused
